# RECIPE TO TRY THIS MONTH

There are a lot of great soup recipes in our Society's cookbook. This one is perfect for October - Pumpkin Soup 'Zuppa di Zucca'

1 cup of water

3 cups of pumpkin, diced

1 T sugar

2 T butter

3 cups of milk

Salt to taste

Mix water, pumpkin, sugar and butter, cook slowly until very tender, adding more water if necessary. Remove from heat and press through a sieve or use a processor. Bring milk to boiling point and add pumpkin. Blend and add a pinch of salt. Reheat and serve with croutons. To fully get into the spirit of Halloween, add a swirl of cream in the shape of a spider web before serving.
