

## **JESSE MILONE MEMORIAL**



Long-time member Jesse Milone passed away on September 20, 2019 at the age of 91. In the late 1980's Jesse worked for Kohll's Pharmacy and for over 25 years he sold Festa tickets at all locations in Omaha. He would distribute the Festa posters, flyers and tickets to all 7 branches of Kohll's Pharmacy. He helped promote the Festa for years and contributed to make it the success that it is today. We thank him and are grateful for all his time and efforts in giving service and support to the Society.
