Omaha Sister City Association Recognizes the Italian Community

The Omaha Sister City Association, OSCA, will hold their annual dinner gala at the Palazzo in early May. This will be the first time in our city's history that the Italian community will be recognized by OSCA, validating the hard work and dedication of our ancestors who immigrated to Omaha over a 100 years ago. This special event will formally announce the inclusion of Carlentini, Sicily, Italy, as the newest Sister City to our city of Omaha. OSCA will recognize the first phase with an official "friendship agreement" between Omaha and Carlentini at their gala to be held at the Palazzo. Dignitaries including our Mayor Jean Stothert and Congressman Don Bacon will recognize the newly inducted city of Carlentini into the fold of six recognized Sister Cities of Omaha. This recognition is an historic event for our Italian community.

Italian Meat Pies - Pasteri

Filling:

3 lbs. ground beef (coarse)

6-7 eggs

6-7 cloves garlic finely chopped

1 lg bunch fresh parsley finely chopped

1 T. oregano

1 T. sweet basil

1 lb. grated parmesan or romano cheese

2 t. salt / 1 t. black pepper

Crust:

3 c. flour

1/2 t. baking powder

1/2 t. salt

2 heaping T. Crisco

2 eggs

1/2 c. milk

Filling: mix all ingredients together Crust: Mix the dry ingredients and cut in Crisco with fork or pastry mixer. Add eggs and mix well, Add milk and mix until dough is soft and elastic. Roll out dough and cut rounds about the size of a saucer or desert dish. Fill each round with hamburger mixture. Pinch sides of dough together tightly. Flute, pinching firmly so dough holds together when baking. Bake for 25-30 minutes at 425 degrees.
