#### **Pickled Banana Peppers**

#### Page 154, A Taste of Italy

1 t. salt per quart + 1/2 tsp. alum

10 1/2 oz white vinegar

Banana peppers, hot or sweet

1-2 whole garlic cloves

1-2 stalks, celery, cut into 2 inch pieces

21 ounce water or fill to top of jar

Thoroughly wash and rinse jars. Put vacuum lids in small pan; cover with boiling water. Use unblemished fresh peppers, clean with a damp cloth, cut lengthwise and remove seeds. Lay empty jar on its side; pack very firmly with cut peppers. Add to each quart jar a 1 or 2 whole garlic cloves, celery pieces and salt. In a large bottle, make a brine consisting of vinegar and water. Let brine come to a boil and immediately ladle the hot brine into packed pepper jar. Fill to within 1/4 inch from head of jar. Adjust hot vacuum lids to jars and screw bands on tight. Store in a cool dry place. Can be served after 3 weeks. **Note**: if sweet peppers are used, add a bit of chopped hot peppers to give a zing.
