# **JULY MEMBERSHIP MEETING SUMMARY**

The membership meeting was held on July 8, 2019 and called to order by President Dr. Terry Bolamperti with 38 members in attendance. It was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance with veterans Lou Buda and Steve LaGreca as flag bearers. There was a moment of prayer for ill members of the Society including member Kim Neppl who was recently hospitalized. The June meeting minutes were read and approved. The Treasury Report was given and approved.

Old Business was discussed including the June Sausage Fundraiser. All sausage orders along with olives and peppers were sold. We also sold all the Society specialty food items including meatballs, spaghetti sauce, salad dressing and Rotella's sausage buns. We want to thank all the members who volunteered to help make the sausage, olives and peppers and also the group that got together to make the meatballs sold at this fundraiser. We want to thank Barbara Pence who does a fabulous job at selling the Society's specialty food items that are not pre-ordered. Special thanks also goes out to Wayne Moore who chaired this successful Sausage fundraiser. He and all of his crew received a round of applause from the members.

All members were reminded to send in their yearly dues as soon as possible if they haven't already done so. Dr. Terry reported that the Spaghetti sauce and cheese grating for Festa has been completed. Special thanks was given to Bob Rodino and his crew for making the sauce and Terry Bolamperti and his crew for grating all the cheese.

New Business was discussed including the Festa food preparations. Dr. Terry stressed that we NEED MORE VOLUNTEERS for the huge job of preparing all the food for the Festa which includes (spaghetti sauce and grated cheese completed) meatballs, sausage, salad dressing, pastries including cannoli and biscotti along with cracked olives, pepper sauce and many other food items. Members were asked to refer to the Festa Food Preparation Schedule in the newsletter to see if they are available to volunteer.

The Festa was discussed briefly and Dr. Terry noted that we are still in need of Festa Captains for several booths and we are also in need of volunteers to work booths for the captains. Dr. Terry also asked for Festa Volunteers to help unload the supply truck and help set up the booths before Festa along with tear down and clean up after the Festa on Monday, Labor Day. It was announced that the Festa Captains meeting will be held Wednesday, July 31 at 7 p.m. at the Palazzo.

Steve La Greca announced that he is starting an Italian Honor Guard which will be similar to the Knights of Columbus. The Italian Honor Guard will participate in the Festa mass held at the Palazzo and also in the Santa Lucia procession starting at St. Frances Cabrini Church. Members from these two Italian Societies were invited to become an Italian Honor Guard.

Lastly, Dr. Terry announced that the management of the Palazzo rentals would be handled by a company called The Omaha Event Group. They manage several other facilities and the Board has voted to accept this new contract with them. In this contract the Society will retain its ownership and use of the facility for any events that we schedule throughout the year. It is anticipated that this will be a win-win situation. Several changes in the ballroom will be taking place.
