



4 boneless, skinless chicken breast halves

2 eggs, beaten

1 c. Italian bread crumbs

1/4 c olive oil

2 c. meatless spaghetti sauce 1/2 c grated parmesan cheese 8 slices of mozzarella cheese

Preheat the oven to 400. With a meat mallet, flatten chicken breasts to 1/4-inch thickness. Dip chicken into beaten egg and then into bread crumbs coating completely. Heat a medium skillet then add oil, cook chicken in oil until lightly golden brown on both sides. Pour sauce in baking dish. Place chicken on top of sauce,
