The Mayor of Carlentini, Sicily Visits Omaha and Attends the Santa Lucia Festival

The 98th celebration of the Santa Lucia Festival was held in Omaha on July 21-24 in Little Italy on 10th and Williams Street in front of St Frances Cabrini Church. This religious celebration started 98 years ago in 1924 by immigrants from Carlentini Sicily. Most came to Omaha in the early 1900's to work for the busy Union Pacific Railroad. The celebration of Santa Lucia in Carlentini is in its 401st year. Saint Lucy has been venerated in thanks for the many miracles experienced in Carlentini over 400 years ago. The local Omaha immigrants from Carlentini continue this longstanding celebration of their heritage from their home town in Italy. What makes it so special this year is because the Mayor of Carlentini came to Omaha to visit and experience the religious celebration brought to Omaha from his home town. Mayor Giuseppe Stefio and his wife along with his press secretary and Eleanora Formica came with the assistance of the Sister City Project (Omaha-Carlentini) orchestrated by the local Sicula Foundation with the support of the major Italian organizations in Omaha, the Santa Lucia Festival Committee, the Omaha Chapter of the Sons of Italy and our American Italian Heritage Society. Sherry Kanger and the Sicula Foundation held fundraisers to make it possible to sponsor the visit of the Carlentini group to Omaha and hosted many activities here in Omaha. They offered tours around special to the group with a very busy itinerary. Most of this was done to progress with the Sister City Project. The Mayor of Carlentini met with Omaha's Mayor Stotherd several times. The highlight was when both mayors of the strongly connected cities addressed the crowd at the opening ceremony of the Santa Lucia Festival. They welcomed each other warmly. Mayor Stotherd will be returning the favor by visiting Carlentini, Sicily and Mayor Stefio in September next month. There will be many other cultural exchanges between the two cities soon. Mayor Stefio and his group were impressed by our city of Omaha and looks forward to welcoming our Mayor Stotherd and a large group from Omaha traveling to Carlentini. The group from Carlentini enjoyed their visit here but I think their warmest memories were meeting the people and the relatives of those who immigrated to Omaha from his hometown. They were at the Santa Lucia for all 4 days and attending the memorial mass at St Frances Cabrini for St Lucy and marching in the parade through the old neighborhood had to be a stirring memory as both cities have kept this tradition of Italian heritage alive for so many years and many so generations.

SOCIETY'S GENEROSITY REMEMBERED for CARLENTINI EARTHQUAKE

In 1992 there was a devastating earthquake in Carlentini Sicily. The AIHS had many members who immigrated to America from Carlentini and many had relatives still living in the destructed town of Carlentini. Member Alfio Gagliola contacted the Society's President at the time, Dr Ted Bolamperti, requesting that our Society have an event to raise funds for the Italian citizens of Carlentini. Our Society came to their aid by holding a spaghetti dinner at our home on 14th and Pine. It was successful as our members volunteered and supported the fundraiser. All of the money raised was sent to Carlentini to help the earthquake devastated town. Alfio Gagliola made sure it got to the proper channels in his home town.

Thirty years later at this years Santa Lucia festival, Dr Terry Bolamperti and his wife Micky, met the visiting mayor of Carlentini, Giuseppe Stefio and his wife Valeria LaRocca and guide Eleonora Formica. The AIHS was supportive of the Sister City (Omaha-Carlentini) Project who was instrumental in bringing Mayor Stefio to Omaha. Alfio was present and approached us and thanked our organization for all that we do as a Society for the Italians of Omaha. He then told Mayor Stefio (in Carlentini dialect) that we were the Italian organization that held a fundraiser thirty years ago for the earthquake devasted Carlentini and sent them the proceeds. Mayor Stefio instantly remembered the nearly \$4,000.00 donation our organization sent to the city in 1992. He was very excited, appreciative and grateful and could not thank our Society enough for our generosity. It was a heartwarming moment. Mayor Stefio immediately had a photo taken with Dr. Terry Bolamperti and himself with a hand shake of appreciation. Alfio translated for the Mayor stating that they were going to put an article on it in the Carlentini newspaper the next morning and also post it on the Carlentini Facebook page. It was so nice and gratifying that they remembered instantly when Alfio reminded them of our donation in 1992. They were genuinely appreciative. We thanked Alfio Gagliola for interpreting this story that our Society's generosity was remembered for over thirty years
