#### **May 2022 Membership Meeting Report**

She and her husband Joe have lived in Omaha for a long time and have three children, two daughters who graduated from Skutt Catholic High School and a son who graduated from Creighton Prep. Lisa's family grew up in Clearfield, Pennsylvania, near Pittsburgh, with many relatives still residing there. Her mother and father family names were Brigandi and Santinoceto, whose Italian roots came from Gioiosa Marea, Sicily and Carpineto, Romano, Lazio. There will be exchanges between the two cities. Representatives from Carlentini will visit Omaha this summer during the Santa Lucia Festival in July. Mayor Jean Stothert along with an entourage from Omaha, will travel to Carlentini in September. Exchange students from Carlentini and Omaha will study abroad in their Sister City. Exchanges of history, foods and ideas are also planned to be shared. This process is in its early stages and more information will emerge as the project expands and grows. The AIHS wishes success to this project and Shari Kanger was thanked for a well done presentation of the progress of this venture.

The meeting was adjourned. We welcome all to the next Membership Meeting which will be held on Monday June 13, 2022 at the Palazzo.

#### Marinated Mostaccioli Salad

2 lbs. mostaccioli

1 1/2 c. oil

3 c. cider vinegar

1 c. sugar

1 tsp. salt

1 tsp. coarsely black pepper

#### Page 36 A Taste of Italy

1 tsp. garlic powder

2 T. prepared mustard

2 cans pitted black olives,

chopped

2-3 cucumbers, sliced thin (opt.)

1 red onion, sliced thin

5-6 T chopped fresh parsley

Prepare mostaccioli according to package directions. Drain, cool and coat well with oil. Add chopped black olives, cucumber, onion and parsley. Prepare marinade (first 6 ingredients after mostaccioli) in large jar with lid. Shake well. Pour over all ingredients. Refrigerate for 24 hours before serving. **Note:** This recipe can be cut in half if desired as it makes a large amount; also the marinade can be used as you desire as it makes more than enough for the salad. I use 2/3 of marinade to pour over salad when preparing it and reserve 1/3 to add later if desired.
